Exclusive 4x4 off-road tour in the Diamond Restricted Area in Namibia...

Luderitz to Walvis Bay Adventure



We will find our way to Luderitz to join the most adventurous dune driving forbidden land desert tour

Day 1

On the first day and drivers can experience some challenging dune driving before reaching the camp at area of Sylvia Hill/ Uri Hauchab mountains area, for a well-deserved rest.

Day 2

The second day visit Suzy/ Sylvia Hill Dune driving/ Koi San people huts and camp north of Sylvia Hill.

Day 3

Visit the 'stompneus' Ford and the Bulldozer before crossing into the dune belt on way to Meob Bay. From here on participants will experience 'camping under the desert sky' in true expedition style. Dunes are getting progressively higher and driver experience and skills acquired during the previous 2 days will be tested and honed to perfection.



Day 4

The dune belt opens up at Meob bay and it is in this stretch between Meob Bay and Conception Bay that where active diamond mining were in the order of the day during the early 1900's The Settlements of Holsatia, Charlottenfelder and Grillenberger are visited on the way.

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Day 5

From Holsatia the trail leads to Conception Bay and along the beach northwards towards Sandwich Bay. On route the wrecks of the Eduard Bohlen & Shawnee are visited. Passing 'Langewand' where massive dunes ends in the sea, given a very limited time span to negotiate this stretch of beach. After Langewand the trail once again leads into the dunes, circumnavigating the Salt Pans 'extensions' of Sandwich Harbour. The dunes are still getting progressively larger to offer an ever changing new experience of ultimate dune driving. The night is spend approximately 1.5km from the sea close to Sandwich Bay at URI Adventures' 'Sandwich camp'.

Day 6

From Sandwich the trails enters the 'Roller Coaster', a series of massive 'roaring' slip faces, not only giving the participants only a new thrilling experience but also offering breathtaking views of Sandwich Harbour and a panorama of Sandscapes exiting onto the beach south of Walvis Bay. The trail ends at Walvis Bay after a final 50km stretch of beach driving. Overnight in Swakopmund for a fantastic civilised rest with good wine and seafood.

Day 7

Heading back to Windhoek via the fourth largest six million hectar Namib Naukluft Park in the world, with many different antelope and species.

Please remember, you are about to participate in one of the most adventurous 4 x 4 desert trips in the world. We need special permit granted by the government, since this is restricted area.

Due to the different items, petrol cans etc which have to be strapped and stored properly, and dune driving enjoyment, preferably only 2 adults per car.

- "Communal" camping equipment (e.g. braai grid, cooking facilities & equipment, tables, wash-up facilities, toilet, Showers etc.)
- English, German language guiding
- Tents, folding chairs and sleepwear (bedroll, sleeping bags etc.)
- Eating utensils (cutlery, plate, glass or mug)
- Refreshments and snacks
